

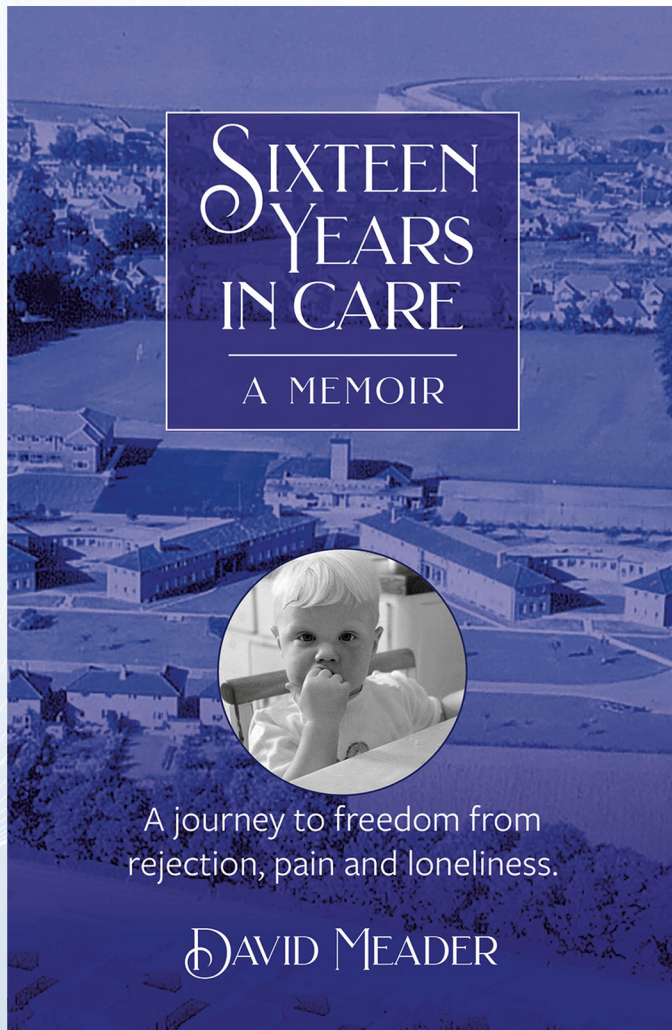
# Sixteen Years in Care
